**Fire Department Use Only:** 

- \$86.00 Fee for up to sixty day permit.
- Scaled footprint of blasting site AND surrounding area(s).
- o Copy of **current** insurance policy on file with the Raymond Fire Department.
- Record of vibration / sound recording devices delivered to the Raymond Fire Department.
- Record of blast per Saf-C 1607:03 (2) delivered to the Raymond Fire Department.
- Minimum one hour notification to the fire department with the name of the blasting company and blast location.
- Town of Raymond Officials may witness each blast at the discretion of the Authority Having Jurisdiction
- Surface blasting operations shall be conducted Monday Friday 07:30 17:00 hours. Saturday exception will require a Fire Department Detail
- Pre-Blast inspection as per Saf-C 1607.05 delivered to the Raymond Fire Department
- Must adhere to all applicable State of NH, Federal, and Town of Raymond Blasting Regulations in regards to obtaining, owning, transporting, storing, handling, and using explosive materials.
- The Authority Having Jurisdiction may require mats to prevent fly-rock.
- Fees will be accepted, and a permit will be issued only when all applicable above requirements have been met.
